Beth was homeless for the last three years and had not been attending school. As life became more stable at home, she struggled getting back into the rhythm of homework and regularly attending classes.

After working with her Student Success Coordinator, they were able to work with her on meeting her unique challenges, and by the end of the year, she was passing all of her classes.

Student Success Coordinators work with their school's administration to identify and address their students' most urgent challenges.

72% of students* show academic improvement.

*Students that fully participate receive at least 15 hours of intervention support.

Welcome Baby is a free home visitation program for children up to 36 months old, that supports families and promotes healthy early childhood development.


AMPLIFYING THE IMPACT OF UTAH'S NONPROFITS.

Kyle a senior living in Ogden, has a degenerative disease that affects his peripheral vision.


He struggles to go anywhere, especially when there is a lot of people where he bumps and has difficulties walking about.
