

Family Engagement – Data Snapshot

Demographics

- Single Parent Households - 24.51%
- Renter occupied housing – 64.14%

Ethnicity

- 52.6% indicated they were of some Hispanic descent.
- 31.8% indicated Spanish as primary language spoken in home.

Income

- 38.6% below the poverty line
- 46.9% of children below the poverty line
- Only 11.6% of households make \$60,000+
- Median household income \$31,302

Mobility

Do you plan on moving to a new neighborhood in the next year? A full 26.5% indicate yes (probably will/definitely will).
How long have you lived in this neighborhood? Only 35% have lived in neighborhood over 5 years.

Community Needs Assessment Survey (731 households)

In a typical week, how often do you or any other family members read books to [CHILD]?

Ethnicity and Primary Language

White respondents were significantly more likely to read to their children three or more times per week (80.7%) than Latino respondents (58.6%), and English-speaking respondents were significantly more likely to read to their children three or more times per week (79.7%) than non-English-speaking respondents (48.1%).

Income and Education

Respondents who reported an income below \$20,000 annually were significantly less likely to read to their children at least 3 times per week (65.1%) than those who reported earning more than \$40,000 annually (79.8%). Respondents with an Associate's degree or higher were significantly more likely to read to their children at least three times per week (87.5%) than those with only a high school diploma (60.9%), or less than a high school diploma (51.1%).
